

# Dubai visa requirements

An entry visa can be issued upon arrival at the Dubai International Airport for Nationals (Citizens) from the following countries:

**GCC Countries:** Bahrain, Kuwait, Oman, Saudi Arabia

**Europe:** Andorra, Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Cyprus, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Holland, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Kazakhstan, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Monaco, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Russia, San Marino, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Ukraine, United Kingdom, Vatican City

**Americas:** United States of America, Canada

**Oceanic/Pacific:** Japan, Brunei, Singapore, Malaysia, Hong Kong, South Korea

**Asia:** Australia, New Zealand

Nationals other than those of the above lists require an entry visa which will need to be arranged prior to arrival. If you require a Dubai visa prior to your arrival, there are three options available:

- **UAE Consulate in your Country:** If your country doesn't appear in the above list, please check the link to find out the nearest UAE embassy/consulate in your country: **UAE Embassies**.
